## Special Work Session - Home Rule Charter

The Town Board of Trustees will be holding a work session at Town Hall on **Tuesday, May 29, 2018 from 6:00 – 7:00 pm** to examine the possibility of a switch to a Home Rule Charter form of government, a charter that essentially allows a local community the freedom to write its own constitution.

During this work session the home rule process will be discussed and it will be determined if there is sufficient interest to form and serve on a Home Rule Commission. The Home Rule process will require an election to form the commission and to elect individuals to serve on the commission.

Please be mindful of the watering schedule and make every effort to save water during the upcoming growing season.

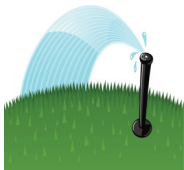
Watering is not allowed between the hours of 10:00 AM and 6:00 PM due to excessive heat and evaporation.
