PARKING REMINDER...

The Lochbuie Municipal code states:

- Parking is prohibited on the side of the street without a sidewalk (per posted signs)
- When parking on the street your vehicle MUST face the flow of traffic
- All vehicles parked on streets MUST bear current registration
- All streets are PUBLIC areas available for parking, unless otherwise posted


