PARKING REMINDER...

The Lochbuie Municipal code states:

- Parking is prohibited on the side of the street without a sidewalk (per posted signs)
- When parking on the street your vehicle **MUST** face the flow of traffic
- All vehicles parked on streets **MUST** bear current registration
- All streets are **PUBLIC** areas available for parking, unless otherwise posted

Seasonal Opportunity!

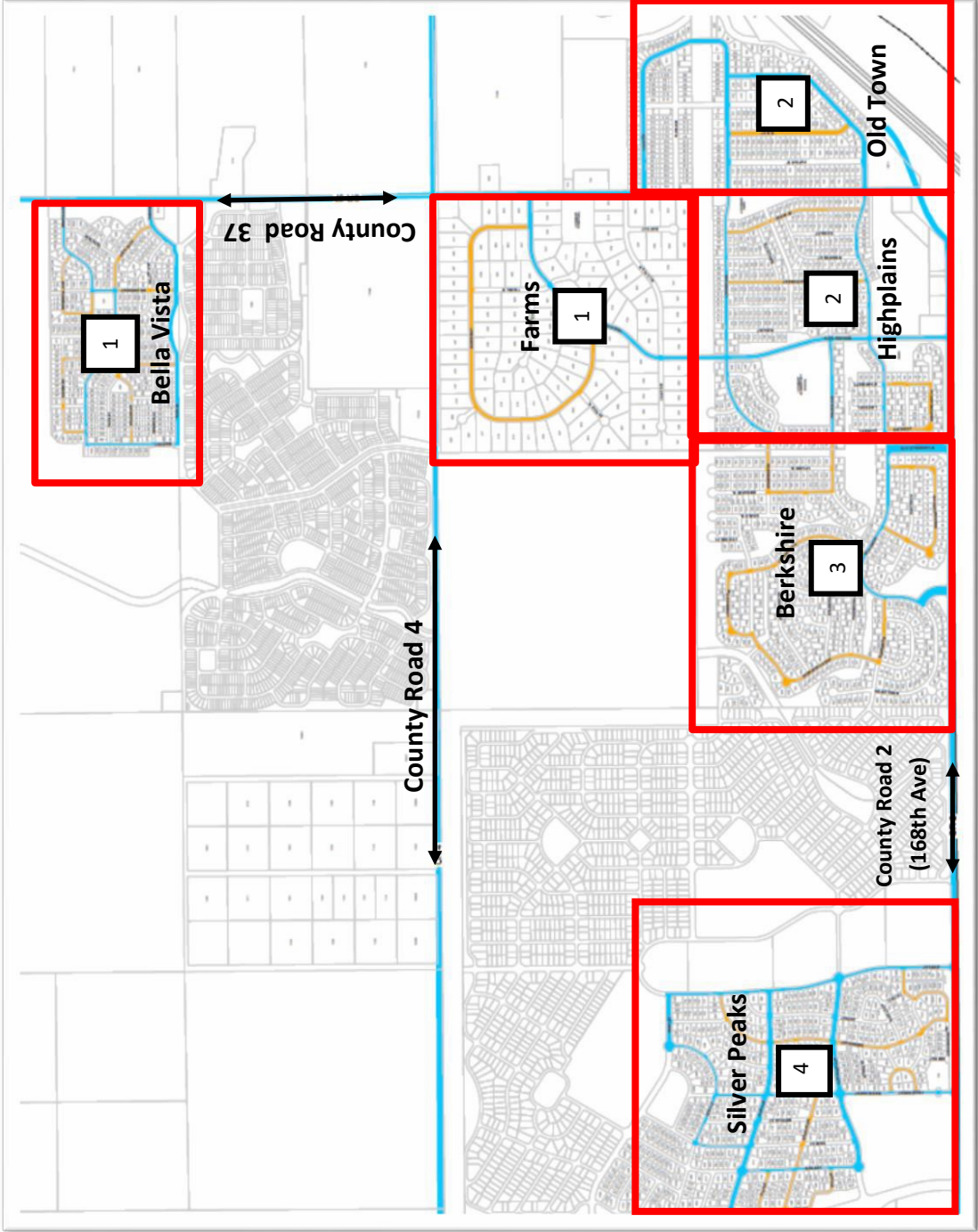

September 2018 Street Sweeping Notice

Public Works Department will be sweeping residential streets starting September 4th, 2018. Sweeping will be divided into 4 zones, each zone represents one week of sweeping. Please obey temporary "NO PARKING" signs placed on cones and small stands one day prior to operations. Additional covers will be placed over the permanent no parking sign in neighborhoods with parking on one side of the street, this will allow staff to sweep both sides of the streets, while giving residents the ability to park on their street. Anticipated hours of operations: 8:00am- 3:00pm

- Zone 2: September 10th - 14th
- Zone 3: September 17th - 21st
- Zone 4: September 24th - 28th

Note: Sweeping of WCR37, WCR4 & WCR2 will occur August 27th - 31st.
