Fellow Lochbuians-

Fall is here! It is, by far, my favorite season of the year, perhaps this year even more than other years.



Here are a few updates on the Town's recent activities:

First, effective September 14, the Town will shift to a 4-10 schedule at town hall. The new hours of operation will be 7am to 6pm, Monday through Thursday. Town administration will be closed on Fridays. This new policy will *not* impact police services, and the department will continue to operate as it has in the past.

Second, the Town's local elections are fast approaching. On the November ballot, you will have the opportunity to select a Mayor and four Trustees. The list of candidates for each position is provided elsewhere in this newsletter.

Third, as you should all now see, the major construction activities on the new round-about and the town's portion of the County Road 2 widening project are now complete. The next few weeks will be spent on some minor detail work and final land-scaping. But all major traffic interruptions are done. We sincerely thank everyone for their support of this project and the patience that you all have shown as this project dragged out longer than expected.

Fourth, the Board filled the trustee vacancy created by the resignation of Trustee Grant Doherty. The Board appointed the only applicant, James Kuemmerle (of Berkshire). His appointment is effective from August 4 until the November 2020 election.

Fifth, the Board recently approved a liquor license for the new 7-11 store. As it stands now, the store is on pace to open in late-September or early-October 2020.

Sixth, the Town will soon be commencing a mill and overlay project on County Road 37. This should vastly improve the condition of the road following Xcel Energy's work in the area over the past several months.

Seventh, the Town Board approved implementation of a "smart water meter" system. Once installed, this system will allow town residents to monitor their own day-to-day water usage. The system will also provide alerts to residents when it notes unusually high water usage. More details about this system are provide in this newsletter, or if you have questions, please contact town hall.

Eighth, the Town Board is in the process of preparing the town's budget for 2021. All residents are welcome to attend the meetings and work sessions relevant to the budget. For details on those meetings, please watch the calendar in this newsletter and on the town's website.

I wish everyone a pleasant fall! And, as always, do not hesitate to contact me or any of the members of the Town Board with your questions, comments, or concerns.

You specify how you want to be contacted: e-mail, text or telephone. When your usage indicates high usage or a leak, we'll contact you. AquaHawk helps prevent costly property damage from unrepaired leaks and gives you peace of mind when you're away from your home.

Monitor your water usage

See how much water you're using and an estimate of your bill anytime during the billing cycle.

Set your Threshold Alerts

Threshold alerts allow you to specify an amount of water (gallons) or a maximum dollar amount that you don't want your bill to exceed. If your usage or your bill is trending to, or has exceeded the threshold value, AquaHawk will send you a notification.
