SNOWPLOWING & SHOVELING

- Please remember that sidewalks must be cleared of snow by the property owner within 24 hours of the end of a snowstorm.
- Do not push snow into the roadway or right-of-way. Pushing snow into the public roadway creates hazards for Town snowplow operators and the public, including drainage problems, drifting, sight obstruction, hindered accessibility, slippery areas, and frozen ruts or bumps that can contribute to motor vehicle or pedestrian crashes.
